1. Please complete the form in block capitals and append a statement as to how you intend to use the funds awarded.
2. Your signature at the bottom will be taken as being that all the details are correct.

4. Please put the name of your parent, guardian or whoever is responsible for your financial support at the bottom of the form.
5. If you are applying for help in order to undertake a specified qualification in Higher Education please be sure to state the name of the institution offering it. The Trust does not award grants for study at A or AS levels or their equivalents.
6. **ELIGIBILITY.** The Trustees are empowered to help young persons under the age of 25 who need financial assistance for their Higher Education. Help will in the first place be given to those whose homes are in the parishes of Northleach with Eastington or Chedworth or who have been educated in either of these two parishes. Secondly it will be given to those under 25 who have been educated or whose homes are in any of the following parishes:-

Aldsworth, Andoversford, Barrington, Bibury, Bledington, Bourton-on the Water, Broadwell, Clapton, Coln St. Denis, Compton Abdale, Condicote, Cutsdean, Dowdeswell, Farmington, Great Rissington, Guiting Power, Hampnett, Hawling, Hazleton, Icomb, Little Rissington, Lower Slaughter, Mangersbury, Naunton, Notgrove, Sevenhampton, Sherborne, Shipton, Stow-on-the-Wold, Swell, Temple Guiting, Turkdean, Upper Slaughter, Westcote, Whittington, Windrush, Winson, Withington, Wyck Rissington, Yanworth.
