In autumn 2018, The Cotswold School celebrates 30 years! Over these last 30 years, the School has grown in numbers and celebrated a number of success stories. As student numbers have grown, capacity has outgrown the facilities available, and in preparation, the School is launching 'For the Next 30 Years Campaign' with a development programme, to ensure the School is fit for purpose for the next 30 years. Below is a timeline for 2017, highlighting the projects around School, to ensure School more than caters for pupil capacity, welfare, academia, curriculum resources and other initiatives and continues to be at the forefront of 'Outstanding' Ofsted Education – *the pursuit of academic excellence and individual achievement within a caring community.*



- New Astro turf from monies raised from Parent contributions and PTA fundraising activities.



- Flagship Sixth Form Centre building work commences.
- PTA Auction of Promises evening raises £10,000.



- New minibus, generously given by anonymous donor.



- Conversion of old Sixth Form into modern Science Labs to meet current capacity of School, concludes Aug 2017.

- Long-awaited NEW toilet facilities, concludes autumn 2017.

- Upgrade of School building roof, concludes Nov 2017.

- For all of the above works - grants & funding applications applied and won.



- New courtyard room, providing temporary classroom space and future multi-purpose use. Monies from a grant, applied and won.



- Upgrade to surface and area of all 6 tennis courts. Monies raised from Parent contributions and PTA fundraising activities.

- NEW Catering Pod Funded by monies raised at Auction of Promises evening – to manage, cater, accommodate and facilitate more meal times and offer more choice. Will be situated in the quad and available for other events!



- NEW SIXTH FORM OPENS



The new Sixth Form costs c £1.5 million. The funding is allocated from S106 monies from recent housing developments in the area; the most significant contributions from the 300 homes new development in Upper Rissington by Linden Homes and Bovis.

- WISH LIST - Fundraising opportunities – new sports pavilion.

- Further building development works – grants being applied for, on a continual basis.

- BUT pupil funding cuts are taking place and we do need as much support as possible.
