Task 1: Research ONE hazard of your choice that has occurred in the past 12 months. You could focus on one of the following:

- Climatic hazard (storm? Hurricane?)
- Earth hazard (landslide? Mudflow?)
- Tectonic hazard (volcanic eruption or earthquake)

For the hazard you select you will need to:

- Locate the area affected by your chosen hazard
- Outline the CAUSE of your hazard
- Outline the IMPACTS of your hazard

Task 2: We will be studying three modules throughout Y12, one of which will be 'Changing places'. In preparation for this, we would like you to prepare an A3 sheet introducing BOURTON ON THE WATER – this is not a Year 7 village enquiry!! You will need to make sure that you complete this to an A level standard.

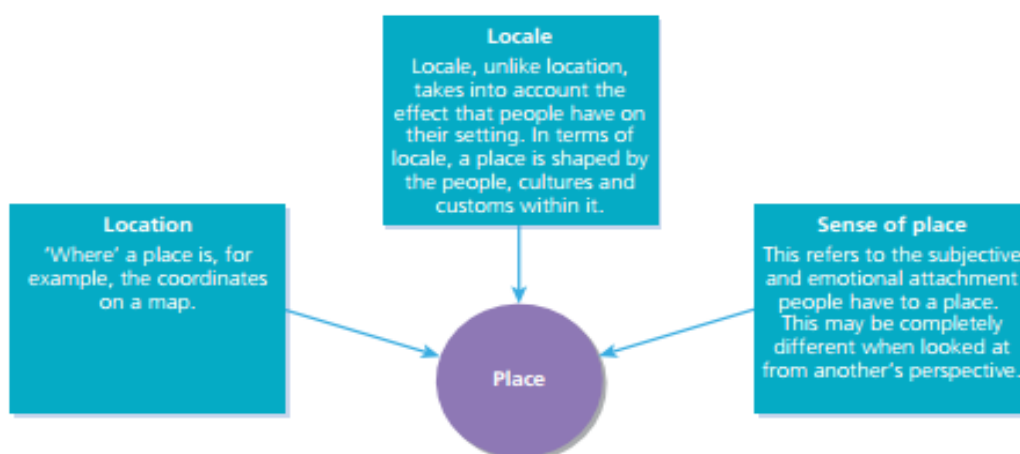


Figure 8.1 The different aspects of place

Your PLACE STUDY NEEDS TO:

1. locate Bourton on the water
2. Population – who lives in Bourton? Ageing population? Well educated? Diverse? Use the ONS website and CDC site (Cotswold District Council) to support you in this
3. Economy – what are the main income streams within the area? Dominant industries?
4. Housing – Character? Cost? Are we a region of home owners or renters?
5. Physical characteristic of the landscape – size of the region, geology, habitats, the variables that have shaped this landscape.
