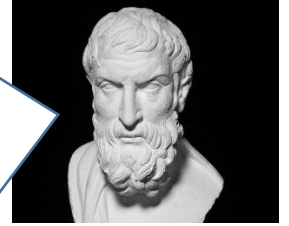

 - Ethics – Situation ethics, utilitarianism, Aquinas’ Natural Law, Euthanasia

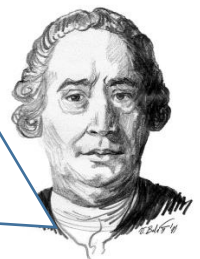
